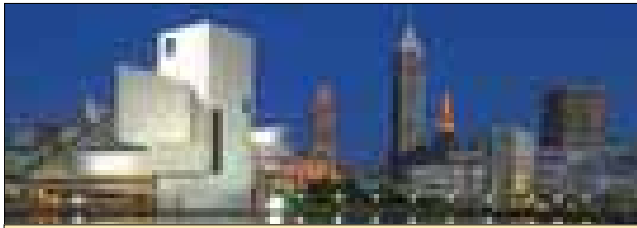




ClevELAnd will be rocking for ELA's 64th Annual Conference
